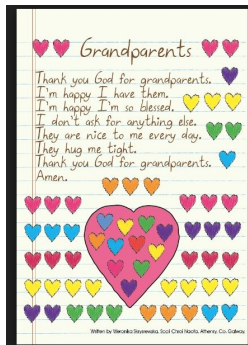




News from St. Mary's
