A reminder that we are still collecting our Christmas hamper items for our St Vincent's De Paul community appeal. Please send in items by 15th November. Thanks

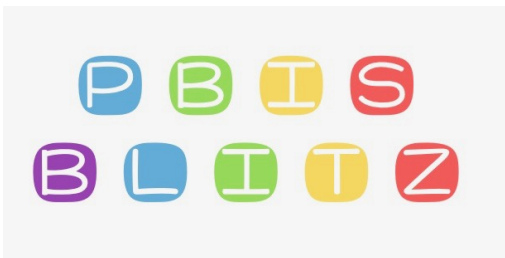


REMEMBRANCE DAY
