WELCOME TO WEEK 5

It is hard to believe that we are in week 5 already and half way through the term. The weather is getting cooler but the days have still been filled with sunshine! Thank you to all of our families with their continued vigilance on keeping unwell children at home. We have noticed the many absences across the school but thank you for your continued support on this.

Last week we officially began our preparations for the Sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation. This year our Year 4 and 5 Learners will combine due to the inability of being able to receive the Sacraments last year. We have nine learners preparing this year. Bishop Shane will join us on the 8th August at 2pm in the Church to celebrate the Sacraments with us. Over the coming weeks we will continue to keep these learners in our prayers.

Our Year 3 and 5 learners last week took part in Naplan. Naplan is a national test that focuses on the areas of Numeracy and Literacy. This is only one snapshot of our learners and is not the only measurement used to track a learners progress. All of our learners did their best and we were proud of all of them. Results arrive towards the middle of Term 3 and will be shared with families along with information of how to read the test results.

Our participation in the Resilience Project is well underway and it is great to see and hear our learners using the language and strategies to nurture healthy mental health. I have been pleased to receive some feedback from parents in the community who have been speaking about GEM with their children and exploring the Parent Hub clips on the website. When school and home both partner in learning we see great benefits.

Tomorrow 13 learners will head to Swan Hill to take part in the first Zone Cross country. We have a great representation of our school and we know that their training and determination will pay off! We hope they all do well and enjoy their day.

A reminder that St Mary's will have a school closure day on Friday so no learners are to be sent to school. The staff of St Mary's will be taking part in a Staff Spirituality Day exploring Catholic Identity and Indigenous connections to spirituality. We thank all of our families for making alternate arrangements for this day.



Senior School Team

What another great week we have had in the senior learning spaces. The Year 5 learners did a wonderful job completing the NAPLAN tests.

In writing, the senior learners have been focusing on persuasive writing and the importance of having key arguments and evidence to support their writing. Learners will continue to focus on persuasive writing using a planner to support their writing piece.

Learners have been exploring some significant events in Australian History. They completed a mini research project on a selected topic of either Ned Kelly, Federation, Pioneers and Torres Strait Island. Learners researched their selected topic to find out interesting 'knock your socks off' facts and the impact made on Australian History.

In Inquiry, learners have developed a wondering that they would like to investigate. They will begin to research their investigation questions this week.

In Mathematics, we have been focusing on addition and learning a range of strategies to solve addition equations. Learners have been also solving word problems and learning to use the important information in the problem.

Learners will get new spelling words on Monday and we will be having our spelling tests on Thursday.
