Flying Doctor School Dental Program

The Flying Doctor Dental team will now be visiting St. Mary's in August or September to provide FREE dental check-ups and education about healthy teeth and gums. Please be aware that this dental check-up is a basic evaluation and does not take the place of a full comprehensive dental examination. If you would like your child to have a dental check-up, please complete the consent form which will be sent home shortly, and return it to school. After your child's check-up, the dental team will send home a report. If your child requires follow-up treatment this will be stated in the report. The mobile public clinic will be in town shortly after and your child can have their treatment completed at no cost, or you can visit your nearest public or private practice. Senior School Team

Wowee what an amazing experience the Year 5/6 learners had at their camp last week! Well done to all of the learners, everyone pushed themselves out of their comfort zone in a number of ways, and of course created wonderful memories. Watch out for next week's newsletter when some of the 5/6's share their recounts of the camp.

In the classroom, the Year 5/6 's are working on recounts for their writing, using their experiences on camp to revise this text type, and remembering to include lots of detail and description. The 3/4 's are focusing on how to change information into their own words. In Religion, the learners are continuing to identify the different Sacraments within the Catholic church, this week focusing on the Holy Orders, while the 3/4 's are writing their own prayers. In maths, the Year 5/6 's will be revising their understanding of the 4 processes, as well as using their knowledge of shape to build a geographical landmark linked to our Inquiry topic. They will also be learning about different angles. The year 3/4 class will be identifying the time using analogue and digital clocks, and revising the correct way to read time. In Reading, we are learning about how Australia is connected to other parts of the world, while identifying why the author chose different techniques to use in their writing.

Congratulations to all learners that represented our school at the next stage of Athletics in Kerang, a superb effort by all and a special mention to those learners whole will be going onto the next stage in Swan Hill, we wish them all the best.

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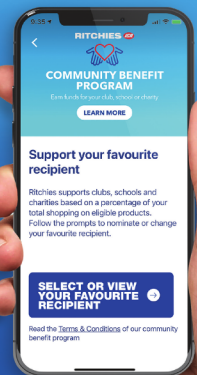
