# Flying Doctor School Dental Program

The Flying Doctor Dental team will be visiting St. Mary's on **WEDNESDAY 23RD NOVEMBER** & will return on **THURSDAY 24TH NOVEMBER** to see our grade 3/4's who will be back from camp this day to provide FREE dental check-ups and education about healthy teeth and gums. Please be aware that this dental check-up is a basic evaluation and does not take the place of a full comprehensive dental examination. After your child's check-up, the dental team will send home a report. If your child requires follow-up treatment this will be stated in the report. The mobile public clinic will be in town shortly after and your child can have their treatment completed at no cost, or you can visit your nearest public or private practice. # Senior School Team

Check out what we have been learning in the Senior classes!

Year 3/4

Reading: identifying the punctuation in texts and the importance it has when reading.

Writing: continuing to write our explanation texts on our chosen topic.

Maths: building on our understanding of money.

Inquiry: participating in a range of experiments that show the changes in gas and being able to see gas.

Religion: sharing our new knowledge of Reconciliation by writing a story that shows forgiveness.

The Year 3/4 camp is coming up quickly, and it looks like there are some excellent activities planned! We know that it will be a great time away.

Year 5/6

Reading: Continuing to build our understanding of a text response. Learning to locate evidence in a text that answers a question.

Writing: Learning to locate evidence in a text and write it as either a quote or paraphrase.

Maths: Building an understanding of vocabulary of mass, location and transformation. Understanding and following the order of BODMAS to solve problems.

Inquiry: Completing experiments and exploring the different states of matter. RE: completing pre assessment on their knowledge of Feasts of the Christmas Season.
