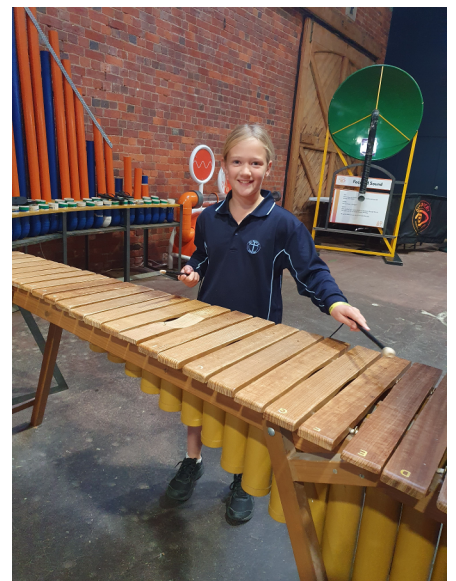
Help Me Overcome Any Hurdles


